<b>Wed., May 15, 2019</b>	<b>DEADLINE: Schools Submission Deadline</b> <b>Virginia Code of Laws</b> §22.1-93, Council must adopt budget for Schools by May 15, or within 30 days of receipt of state school funding estimates to localities, whichever shall occur later.
<b>Friday., May 31, 2019</b>	<b>DEADLINE: Budget Adoption Deadline</b> <b>Richmond City Charter</b> §6.11 - Council shall adopt Budget not later than May 31.
<b>July 1, 2019</b>	<b>New Richmond City Council FY 2020 Richmond Government Budget begins</b>
